REFER TO A SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST FOR A SWALLOW ASSESSMENT WHEN.

Newborn:

- Cannot coordinate swallowing
- Excessive choking when sucking
- Prolonged feeding time
- Extreme fussiness during feeding

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By 9 months:

- Cannot manage puree from a spoon
- Cannot clean spoon with upper lip
- Choking/coughing when eating and drinking

By 15 months:

- Cannot manage small pieces of soft solids
- Drools outside of teething
- Choking/coughing when eating and drinking
